Filipino MMA star Jeremy “The Juggernaut” Pacatiw wins in the Brave 17 MMA event in Lahore, Pakistan



29 October 2018– Filipino mixed martial arts (MMA) star Jeremy “The Juggernaut” Pacatiw of Team Lakay secured a historic victory over a Pakistani opponent Uloomi Karim at the co-main event of the Brave 17 Mixed Martial Arts held on 27 October 2018 at the Nistar Park Sports Complex in Lahore, Pakistan. Brave 17 is the first International mixed martial arts that took place in Pakistan and marks the seventh appearance for Pacatiw in Brave Combat Federation. Two other Filipinos, ArbenEscayo and Ariel Oliveros also fought in the under card matches. Currently, Pacatiw holds a professional record of 8-3-0 and is ranked 13th out of 96 active Middle East Pro Bantamweights. He also has the most number of appearances in the Brave Combat

Federation.
