Guidelines for Voters Who Recently Changed Address and those Who prefer to Vote On Site (Pakibasa po ng maigi)

1. Changed Address

Due to multiple queries, the Philippine Embassy informs registered voters in Pakistan that we are conducting a survey of voters who have recently updated their address. If you have recently changed your address, kindly open the link below and complete the details. Please select voting by “Mail” at the bottom of the form and attach a photo of your PASSPORT/Valid ID and proof of new address so that your ballot shall be sent to the proper address. Please accomplish by 10 April.

2. On-Site Voting (Do not read if you prefer to vote by Mail)

A. Embassy in Islamabad (10am to 2pm. 10 April to 09 May 2022, INCLUDING weekends) - During weekends only, a shuttle service shall be provided by the Embassy to pick up and drop off voters at TOTAL PARCO Petrol station, Diplomatic Enclave, Islamabad. Please bring your passport or any proof of identity. Those voting during weekdays shall go through the private regular shuttle service provided for at the Diplomatic Enclave.

B. Honorary Consulate in Lahore (Tentative Dates: 23-24 April 2022) 10am to 6pm

C. Honorary Consulate in Karachi (Tentative Dates: 16-17 April 2022) 10am to 3pm

For this mode of voting, please also register at the same link and select “Vote Personally” at the bottom of the form.

Kindly note that all arrangements above are tentative. It is also possible for the start date (10 April) to be DELAYED due to the shipment clearing of election supplies and materials. The Embassy shall inform the general public through a similar press release once the voting period officially and finally opens. Please stand by for further announcements.

If no information is received through the link from the voter by 10 April, then the Embassy shall send the ballot to the existing address of the voter in accordance with the standard mail voting process. All mailed ballots should be returned and received by the Embassy NO LATER than 09 May.
