The Team found OFW “Aida” to be well on her way to recovery. Through the constant help of her friends, she was rushed to the hospital and given timely medical assistance that is crucial in saving her life.

The direct and unselfish assistance of Dr. Sheikh in providing medical care, even to the point of volunteering to give his own blood when it was needed, was decisive in saving the life of OFW “Aida”.
