3 December 2018 – H.E. Ambassador Daniel Ramos Espiritu opened the 2018 celebration of International Day of Persons with Disabilities at the Karachi Vocational Training Centre (KVTC) with this year's theme: "Empowering persons with disabilities and ensuring inclusiveness and equality".

KVTC, which was founded in 1991, is a rehabilitation centre for intellectually challenged children, teens, and adults. The institution is the first of its kind in Pakistan and the first to introduce IEP and IVP based curricula for special needs children to ensure their proper care, development, and successful social inclusion.
