PHILIPPINE AMBASSADOR MEETS WITH TOP GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL IN KARACHI

27 November 2017 – Ambassador Daniel Ramos Espiritu called on the Governor of Sindh Mohammad Zubair Umar on 22 November 2017 at the Sindh Governor House in Karachi.

During the call, Ambassador Espiritu highlighted the growing bilateral cooperation between the Philippines and Pakistan and briefed the governor on trade and investment opportunities under the Duterte's Administration.

For his part, Governor Umar noted the recent visit of Philippine officials from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and encouraged future visits of Philippine officials and business leaders to spur further economic cooperation.
