An Easier and Faster Way of Document Notarials/Legalization

Foreign documents from Pakistan and other Apostille countries will only need Apostillization by the host government for them to be validly used and accepted in the Philippines. Philippine Embassies/Consulates shall no longer authenticate documents originating from Pakistan and other Apostille countries under its jurisdiction.

Documents from non-Apostille countries under the Embassy's jurisdiction, namely Afghanistan, will still need authentication from the host government and the Philippine Embassy.

For Private Documents Requiring Personal
Legalization/Execution at the Embassy in Islamabad, Pakistan.

- Original and one (1) photocopy of the document and all enclosures. Document/s should be signed by the signatories/affiants before a Consular Officer.
- If the Document/s are executed by a foreign national, they should be attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MoFA).
- Original and two (2) photocopies of a valid identification card (preferably a passport, national identification card (NIC), etc.) for each set of documents.
- Processing Fee (PKR 7,500.00) (Payable in cash only)
