The Philippine Embassy in Islamabad attended the Pakistan Expo on Disaster Risk Reduction (PEDRR) on 8 May 2025, reaffirming the Philippines' strong commitment to advancing regional cooperation in disaster preparedness, risk mitigation, and climate resilience.

Organized by the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) of Pakistan in collaboration with local and international partners, the PEDRR brought together policymakers, humanitarian actors, experts, and representatives of the diplomatic community to showcase innovations, strategies, and best practices in disaster risk reduction (DRR).

Representing the Embassy was First Secretary and Consul Juan Paolo G. Alix who visited the exhibit booths featuring cutting-edge technologies, local community resilience initiatives, and joint multilateral programs on disaster risk management.
