## **EXTENSION OF TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS FROM TRAVELERS COMING FROM INDIA, PAKISTAN, NEPAL, SRI LANKA, BANGLADESH, UNITED ARAB EMIRATES, AND OMAN UNTIL 15 JULY 2021**

### **IATF RESOLUTION NO. 123 Series of 2021**

Cognizant of the continuous prevalence of COVID-19 Delta variant and the need for the continued implementation of proactive measures and restrictions particularly on international border control, travel restrictions currently imposed upon India, Pakistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, United Arab Emirates, and Oman is hereby extended until 15 July 2021.

Restrictions cover BOTH foreigners and Filipinos.

Those Filipinos who have **EMERGENCY** travel or are for repatriation shall have their manning agency (sea-based OFWs), recruitment agency (land-based OFWs), or sponsoring government agency IN MANILA request **DIRECTLY** from DOH Bureau of Quarantine(BOQ) a **Certificate of Entry Exemption** in order to be allowed entry into the Philippines. The Philippine Embassy or Consulates **cannot intercede or endorse** any request in this regard.

Not getting a certificate opens you to the risk of getting denied entry upon arrival in the Philippines, give you problems while in transit, or not being issued a ticket at all (practice of some airlines).
